

# Livestreaming Privacy Notice



**Please be aware that we will be livestreaming audio and video from the Thames Hall during this morning's service.**

The livestream will present the 'stage area' (ie. on and immediately in front of the stage), to allow remote participation in our gathering for those people unable to attend due to COVID-19 shielding etc.

We will not use the recording for commercial purposes, but may use parts of it for the church's promotional activities in future.

We are livestreaming directly to Facebook, between 10:30am and the end of the service (typically 12:00pm), with a relay of the same content to the church's website at [oxford.occ.org.uk/sundays](https://oxford.occ.org.uk/sundays) and also to the projection screens in the hall, allowing you to see what is being livestreamed.

*We expect to capture the voices and/or images only of those people who are contributing to the meeting live from the stage area, or from pre-recorded video clips, and we recognise that the livestream will be publicly available on the internet for the foreseeable future.*

There is a possibility that other people could be included in the cameras' fields of view, but they will most likely be silhouetted and/or facing away. We are not using any 'congregation microphones' that would pick up sound indiscriminately from the hall.

If you do not want to be included in the livestream, please avoid the stage area, and do not use any of the microphones - if you have a contribution for the meeting then you may wish to share it with one of the leaders, for them to bring on your behalf.
